## What is Section 98c?



Section 98c appropriates \$52,056,000 in federal funding to address learning loss as part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund and part of the federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) II Fund.

## 98c Funds Focus



The 98c funds will be used to address inequities that have resulted from lost instructional time.

The RRSD plans to utilize 98c funds to ensure that all students have the systems and supports necessary to access Tier I, Tier II, and Tier III grade level content.

### **Data Review:**

Given the 2021-2022 spring baseline NWEA data, the percentage of students that will meet their projected growth goal will increase by 3% in reading and 3% mathematics as measured by the spring NWEA for the 2022-2023 school year.

## **Grant Award**



- Grant funds will be allocated by the state based on pupil count to districts that submit applications and meet grant requirements.
